
\$10,000,000 Overlay Program

Provides Temporary Half-Cent Sales Tax


Expires June 2023






10-Year Renew Arkansas Highways Program



If Issue 1 Fails

<u>State Highways</u> 2023 - \$740 Million 2024 - \$535 Million



<u>City Streets</u> 2023 - \$150 Million 2024 - \$106 Million

<u>County Roads</u> 2023 - \$150 Million 2024 - \$106 Million

30% Annual Reduction

If Issue 1 Fails



<u>Union County</u> 2023 – \$2.5 Million 2024 – \$1.8 Million Loss of Funding – \$700,000 Per Year

<u>City of El Dorado</u> 2023 – \$1.5 Million 2024 – \$1.1 Million Loss of Funding – \$400,000 Per Year
