


## \$10,000,000 Overlay Program

#### **THEN**

In 1998, **200 lane miles** of highway could be overlaid with \$10 million.

#### **NOW**

In 2018, **90 lane miles** of highway could be overlaid with \$10 million.

Provides Temporary Half-Cent Sales Tax


Expires June 2023







2023 - \$740 Million

2024 - \$535 Million

2023 - \$150 Million

2024 - \$106 Million

#### **County Roads**

30% Annual Reduction

#### If Issue 1 Fails



#### **Benton County**

2023 - \$6.1 Million

2024 - \$4.3 Million

Loss of Funding – \$1,800,000 Per Year

#### **Cities of Benton County**

2023 – \$13.8 Million

2024 – \$9.8 Million

Loss of Funding – \$4,000,000 Per Year

#### If Issue 1 Fails



#### **Washington County**

2023 – \$5.6 Million

2024 - \$4.0 Million

Loss of Funding – \$1,600,000 Per Year

#### Cities of Washington County

2023 – \$13.7 Million

2024 – \$9.7 Million

Loss of Funding – \$4,000,000 Per Year
