



I-49 Corridor


- Forth Smith to Texas State Line






Highway 71

I-40 Mississippi River Bridge








Inspecting the I-40 MS River Bridge




































Infrastructure Plans Under Consideration

Senate Bipartisan Infrastructure Deal

- Agreement between President and Senators
- Expect Senate vote this week
- \$304 billion for roads, bridges and safety
- Totals just under \$1 trillion over 5-years
- Arkansas' share is \$3.6 billion over 5-years

House INVEST Act Plan

- Passed U.S. House of Representatives
- 37% increase for roads, bridges and safety
- Totals \$715 billion over 5 years
