**PROCLAMATION**

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME – GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: The State of Arkansas recognizes that construction, maintenance, and repairs must often be done on roads alongside traffic, putting both motorists and workers at risk every day; and

WHEREAS: The responsibility that comes with driving a motor vehicle and the importance of maintaining safe and smart driving habits on our roadways, including work zone safety, are essential for all drivers; and

WHEREAS: It is vital for passenger and commercial vehicles to safely co-exist on our roads and highways and for drivers of those vehicles to be aware and to avoid distractions as they drive; and

WHEREAS: Drivers must also be cognizant of the hazards encountered when driving through highway construction and maintenance work zones;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ASA HUTCHINSON, Governor of the State of Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Arkansas, do hereby proclaim April 11<sup>th</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, as
