## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION NOW REQUIRED FOR BIDDERS LIST

The U.S. Department of Transportation has set forth new guidance concerning its Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) program regulations. This will require significant additions to required Bidders List submittals.

Beginning with the **May 22, 2024** letting, additional information will be required on the Bidders List submitted for all federally funded projects. The following information will be required for **ALL** subcontractors, truckers or material suppliers that bid or provide quotes on any item for the project, regardless of whether the quotes are used in preparing the proposal:

- Firm Name, Address, and Phone Number
- Is the Firm a Certified DBE?
- Race of Majority Owner
- Gender of Majority Owner
- Age of the Firm (selectable options provided)
- Annual Gross Receipts of the Firm (selectable options provided)
- Type of Work (enter appropriate codes from provided options)
- Applicable NAICS Codes (link provided to U.S. Census website to determine codes)

The updated form is attached so that contractors may begin gathering the required information.

Please note that in accordance with ARDOT Standard Specification Section 102.07, Bidders Lists must be submitted for all projects for which a prime contractor has submitted a bid before they will be issued proposals for future bid lettings. ARDOT will monitor bidders' compliance with the new requirement. Additional, more stringent, measures may be implemented as necessitated by the industry's responsiveness.
