


Electric Vehicle Infrastructure





National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Program: What is it?

- Reimbursement program for EV infrastructure funded through the Federal Highway Administration
- Goal is to build a national network of Electric Vehicle charging stations by 2030





NEVI Planning

 First, each state must identify "Alternative Fuel Corridors" (AFCs) to be part of the national network and create a plan for how federal funding will be used



Arkansas' Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Deployment (EVID) Plan




ARDOT EVID Plan Objective

 100% of Arkansas Interstates and designated Alternative Fuel Corridors (AFCs) "fully built out" to NEVI program standards

ARDOT EVID Plan Strategies

- Spur local market investments in EV charging stations
 - Competitive procurement program that awards NEVI funds to owner-operators






Nevi Planning

- 19 projects recommended
 - \$14.9 million
 - 80% NEVI / 20% Private
- Most gaps will be filled
- Another RFP round is needed to reach fully built out status






Speed Enforcement Cameras

- Began August 1st
- Present in Interstate work zones
- Officer must be present to issue citation
- Increases safety for drivers, officers, and road crews






Speed Enforcement Cameras





- Operational during peak travel times
- Functions as a shoulder outside of peak travel times
- Monitored 24/7 by ARDOT's Traffic Management Center
- Eases congestion, more cost effective than widening bridge





Wrong Way Detection

- Research ongoing at Interstate 440/Highway 165 Interchange
- Plans to deploy 161 systems at every exit ramp on I-40, between Little Rock and Memphis
- Improve safety, reduce deaths


